What is the Office of Small Business Assistance?



We are an independent, objective voice for small businesses and nonprofits from within government.

Businesses and nonprofits with 100 or fewer employees can turn to us when they feel they have been treated unfairly by or have unresolved questions of state agencies, boards, commissions and councils or any unit of local government. The team investigates complaints and works with business owners and state agencies toward a mutually acceptable resolution. We are the Information Booth for Oregon businesses, guiding businesses to appropriate resources and answers based on specific need.

Our services are free and confidential, and we are independent and objective. Our role is to aid in the resolution of problems in a non-adversarial manner. We have broad powers to investigate and recommend ways to improve how state agencies interact with small businesses.

The team is given authority through [ORS 56.200-209](#). The team's administrative rules are in [OAR 160-070](#). If you believe your business has been treated unfairly, or if you can't get the information you need, please contact us.

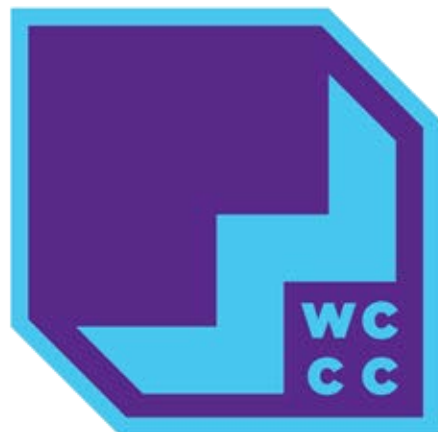

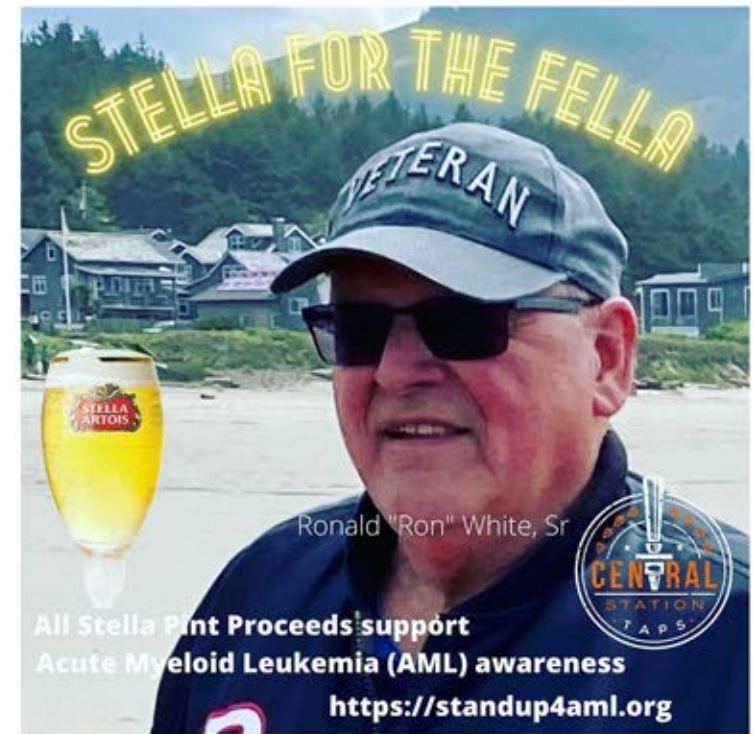
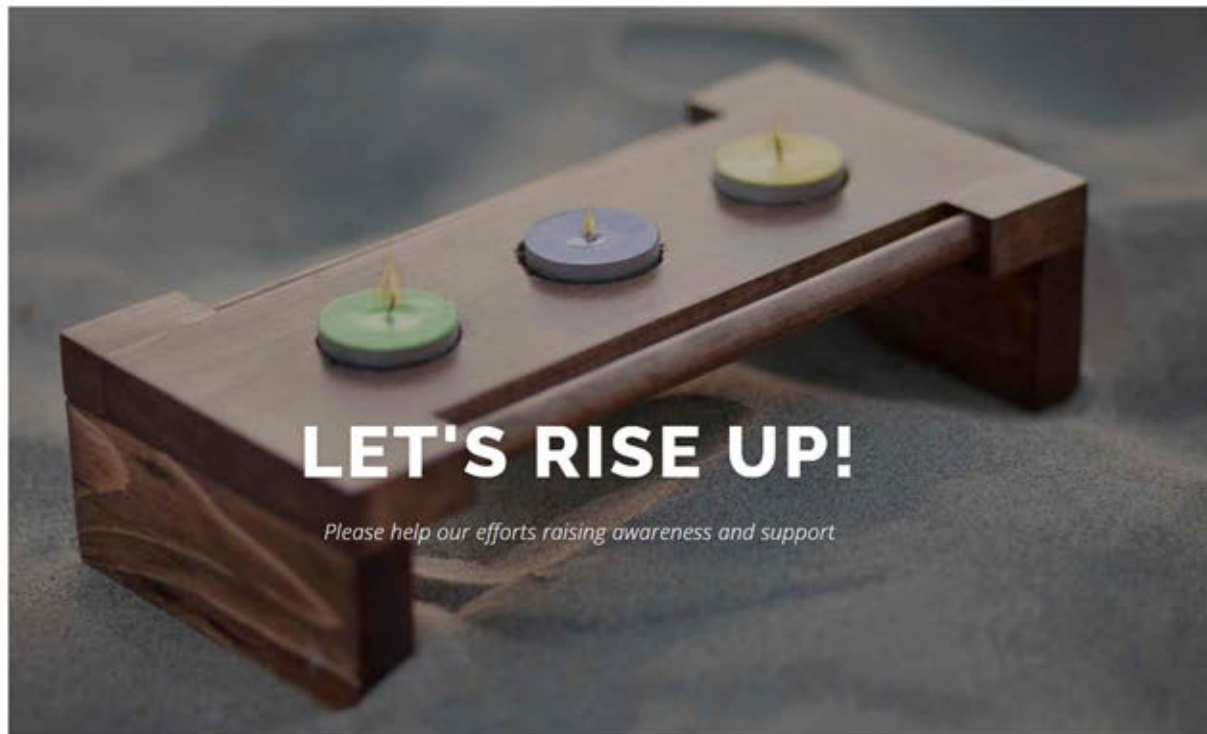
